USEFUL TOP TIPS FOR CLEANING YOUR WASHING MACHINE & TUMBLE DRYER

Even though you constantly remove cleaned clothes from your washer and dryer they still need to be periodically cleaned as well. After many loads of laundry, the inside of your washing machine can get built up residues of dirt and detergent, and the inside of the drum can become contaminated with bacteria. The inside of your dryer can also get a buildup of lint, dust and dirt, so a thorough cleaning of your washer and dryer every few months will mean that your clothes will get cleaner.

Set your **washer** to the hottest, longest wash setting, add two cups vinegar and a quarter-cup of baking soda and start the cycle. Once the cycle is complete, scrub around the inside of the drum with a quarter-cup of water and scrub sponge. Give it a quick dry, and you'll be all set for at least a month.

For the **Dryer** - clean the lint filter thoroughly. Use the narrow wand attachment on your vacuum cleaner to remove as much lint as possible that has built up underneath the filter itself. If you don't have a vacuum, insert a duster into the filter well and wipe up the lint.

Vacuum or wipe down the interior of the dryer, including the door seal.

Check the outside vent. Lift the flap and make sure there isn't any debris or lint blocking the vent, preventing air from escaping freely.

Wash down the top and the exterior of the dryer. Use warm, sudsy water and then rinse the soap residue off.

Spray an all-purpose spray cleaner on the drum and wipe it up with a damp cloth or paper towel.
